# **HB-6A Bluetooth Adapter (with Remote PTT)**



## 1. Pairing and Operation Instructions

#### **Pairing with Your Own Bluetooth Headset**

- 1. Make sure the adapter is powered off.
- **2.** Press and hold the adapter's power button for 7 seconds until the LED flashes red and blue alternately. This indicates pairing mode.
- 3. Put your Bluetooth headset into pairing mode.
- **4.** Wait a few seconds. The adapter will automatically pair with the headset. When the LED flashes blue, the pairing is complete.

#### **Important Compatibility Note:**

To ensure proper function, please use a Bluetooth headset that supports both HSP (Headset Profile) and HFP (Hands-Free Profile). Bluetooth headsets that only support A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile) are not compatible with this adapter, as A2DP is designed for stereo music streaming.

### Power On/Off

- **1.** To power on/off, press and hold the adapter's power button for 3 seconds.
- **2.** Once paired, the adapter will automatically reconnect to the previously paired headset upon the next power-on.

#### **Function of the Adapter Button**

- While the adapter is powered on, pressing the power button once will simulate a PTT hold function, allowing you to transmit without using the remote PTT button.
- This function is useful as a backup if the PTT button is lost or unavailable.

## 2. Replacing PTT Button & Resetting Adapter

#### **Pairing a New Remote PTT Button**

If the original remote PTT button is lost or replaced:

- 1. Turn off the Bluetooth adapter.
- **2.** Press and hold the power button for 7 seconds to enter pairing mode (LED flashes red and blue).
- **3.** Repeatedly press the new remote PTT button until the red LED on the adapter responds to the PTT signal—this indicates successful pairing.

# Resetting the Adapter to Avoid One PTT Controlling Multiple Adapters

If a remote PTT has accidentally paired with multiple adapters:

- **1.** With the adapter powered off, press and hold the power button for over 30 seconds to clear all previous pairing records.
- **2.** Power on the adapter again and re-pair it with your intended PTT button as described above.

## 3. Charging Instructions

- Use the included dual-head USB charging cable to charge both the Bluetooth adapter and the remote PTT button.
- While charging, the LED will stay red.
- When fully charged, the red light will turn off automatically.
- For best results, please fully charge the device before first use.
